Kennet Furniture Refurbiz thrive on the public donation of Furniture and White Goods. Unfortunately we are not able to accept every item we are offered.

KFR cannot accept the following items:

- Gas Appliances
- Refrigeration that does not work
- Sofas, Mattresses and other items that are upholstered that **do not** have their Fire Safety Labels or certificates.
- Soiled, stained or ripped sofas or mattresses
- Soft furnishings and bric-a-brac
- Items beyond repair or not suited to the needs of our clients.

From time to time we may also decline a donation if we have too much of a particular item or are low on space to store it.

We will arrange to view and collect items that we believe may be suited to the charity. Our van crew have the final say on whether items can be collected. We cannot guarantee over the phone to take items and may ask if possible for pictures to be sent to us before we visit.
