



Our History

KFR was formed in April 2013 following a merger between the Kennet Furniture Project and Refurbiz. The Kennet Furniture Project began in 1995 with the aim of helping disadvantaged families by collecting unwanted furniture and selling it at a low cost, at the same time as training volunteers and improving the environment. Refurbiz started in 2003 with similar aims but focussing on white goods such as cookers and washing machines.

Over the years our work overlapped more and more. We shared a building in Devizes and we often borrowed each other's vans so we decided to join forces. We moved into new premises in the Hopton Industrial Estate in April 2013. In 2021, we extended our operations and added the adjoining warehouse, increasing our floor space from 5 to 10,000 square feet.

KFR now covers all the county of Wiltshire.

KFR's mission is to:

- Refurbish furniture and white goods so that quality items are available to families with limited income
- Revive communities by removing unwanted items, reducing landfill and retrain people with new skills.
